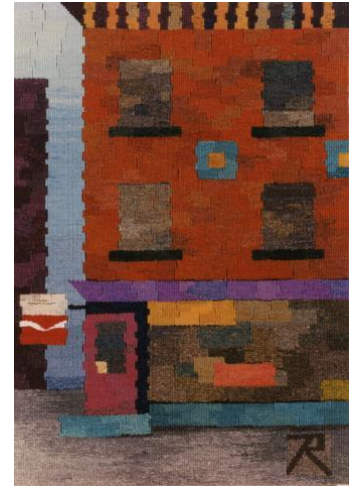

### TAPESTRY ARCHITECTURE: Build Your House

Interested in designing a new house? Explore the basic building blocks of tapestry weaving and discover the unique structure of this special cloth.

In this hands-on workshop you will design your own house using geometric shapes, build one floor on top of the other, and include interesting details. We will focus on learning tapestry techniques as we weave, including shape, building of rectangles and triangles, interlocking, and pick and pick. All levels can gain knowledge from this workshop.

Participants will need a simple frame loom with adjustable tension. You can also use a rigid-heddle loom or a small table loom (we will be working 4" wide). The Instructor has 10 pipe frame looms that may be rented for \$5.00 for use during the workshop.

Ruth will provide all yarns needed, but if you have a special yarn that would make good construction material, bring a small ball to share.
